1.1 Background of the Study

According to Qing (2011), role play is explained as a drawing situation in real life with social events (p.37). Ments (1999) says, in the role of playing each player acts as article of another social environment and provides a framework in which they can test their repertoire of behaviour or learn the interacting behavior of

the group (p. 5). Role of play is explained on the philosophy that meaning is in people, not in symbols or words, it as technique in educating.
