

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

In this chapter, the writer presents the general issues related to the research. They are Background of Study, Reason for Choosing the Topic, Statement of the Problem, Objective of the Study, Limitation of the Study, and Significant of the Study, Outline of the Study.

1.1 Background of Study

There are many languages in the world and one of them is English. English has become language which is used for international communication. Generally, there are four skills in English. They are speaking, reading, writing, and listening. From all the skills, speaking is the most important skill in English because speaking makes people to be able to express their information, ideas, and emotion in communicating with another people (Ur, 1996: 43).

Based on the writer's experience in school teaching practice, the writer found that many students still have difficulty in speaking English although they have learned English for several years. There are many students who are unable to speak fluently. Some of them are lack of vocabulary, pronunciation, grammatical error, lack of confidence, and anxiety. Basically, they are shy and feeling afraid that their classmates will underestimate them when they express opinion in front of their classmates. From the information above, it is true that the ability to speak is affected by not only linguistic but also psychological factors.

The linguistics factors such as grammar, vocabulary, and pronunciation play important role in helping students to speak well (Mebarki: 2015). Three of them are so important to master English. Many students are lazy because they have to master these three things and sometimes they are afraid of failing to learn English. On the other hand, psychological factors such as lack of self confidence, fear of mistakes, anxiety, shyness and lack of motivation play important role too (Ariyanti: 2016). Psychological factor is a key in reaching success for students in their speaking performance (Haidara: 2014). Most of students have learned English for several years but they have difficulty in using language to speak, whereas most of them have good level of vocabulary or grammar.

By using recount text, the researcher analyzed the difficulty of students in their speaking. Djuharie (2007: 44) states that recount text is reconstruction of something that happened in the past. In the recount text, the sentences are usually organized according to the time order or chronological order. One thing happen and then another thing happens, and the events are told in the same order.

Problems in speaking still become the obstacle by the students to increase their English in speaking. Hence, based on the explanation above, the writer would like to find out the problems of speaking faced by students.
