CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

In this chapter the researcher presents Background of the Study, Reason for Choosing the Topic, Statements of the Problem, Hypothesis, Objective of the Study, Significance of the Study, Definition of Key Terms, and Outline of the Report.

1.1. Background of the Study

English is one of the languages in the world with a number of speakers that are almost spread throughout the world and used as a communication medium to interact with other people through out the world, both because of the number and geographical area of the speakers and the large number of native speakers who use it for some of their interaction contacts. Ministry of National Education, said that the ability to be owned by Indonesian students is to understand and disclose information, thoughts, feelings, and develop science, technology, and culture using English.

Lyle (1993) in Bertram (2000) states that speaking skill is a language that is used as a means of communication with others which have an important role and is regarded as a skill that must be done or mastered by students. Because afterwards, they must know how to express thoughts, opinions, feelings, and ideas through language, that's why this ability is so important. Bertram (2000) also adds that oral language is one of the important learning tools and to gain knowledge. They will learn the next skills such as reading and writing after they can apply

their previous abilities well. The better their speaking ability, the more skill they will develop. In fact, throughout life, oral language skills are of the utmost importance for intelligent communication of ideas and conversations. Based on the opinions described above it can be concluded that the meaning of speaking is the ability to speak words in order to convey or express intentions, ideas, thoughts, and feelings that are developed in accordance with the needs of the listener to be conveyed can be understood by listening. The main purpose of speaking is to communicate or send and receive messages or news between two or more people so that the intended message can be understood.

1.2. Reasons for Choosing the Topic

1.3. Research Question

1.4. Objectives of the Study

1.5. Hypotheses

According to Airasian (2000:74), there are two hypothesis, which are :

Ha: There is a significant difference improvement of students' conversational speaking skill after being taught by Self-Directed Dialogue Technique.

Ho: There is no significant difference improvement of students' conversational speaking skill after being taught by Self-Directed Dialogue Technique.

1.6. Significance of the Study

The result of this study is expected to contribute some benefits to students and teachers as follows:

- 1. For the English Teachers, the results of this study is expected to motivate teachers to be more creative so that students will be more enthusiastic in learning English in the classroom. It is also expected can make teachers realize, especially English teachers about the importance of using media such as Picture or Identification Card to facilitate students during teaching learning process become more enjoyable and meaningful.
- 2. It is also expected to provide them with alternative techniques and encourage students' ability to boost their confidence in English conversation with strangers.

1.7. Definition of Key Terms

1. Speaking

Speaking is a productive skill that can be directly and empirically observed (Brown, 2004:140). Speaking is the key to communication. Teachers can help students improve their speaking skills as a whole by considering what tasks can be used and learning strategies speak what needs to be applied in the classroom. In conclusion, speaking is an interactive process of involving two participants between the speaker and the listener, which is in the process of conversation it can be measured through conversation with the language aspects which are obtained through the interaction between either.

2. Self-Directed Dialogue

Self-Directed Dialogue Technique is role playing activities or learning simulations in English class which is done by group learning, but overall the students must be able to think independently in their own learning (Joiner, E, 1978). Self-Directed Dialogue is a technique that can help students improving their speaking skills. As quoted in Herwanah (2012): Self-Directed Dialogue is one of the most appropriate learning techniques to be applied in speaking class.

3. Conversation

Conversation is two or more people in which they express thoughts and ideas. In conversation, people can ask questions, ideas, test comprehension, and also solve problems. In this case, students must study hard and teachers should create a good atmosphere in the classroom.
