

It means the role between men and women in society are different, it is following by values and belief in society. Thus, roles of women in society are more passive than men. However by following the era, there are the role changes between women and men in society, especially women. Thus, this study will discuss about the differences of women gender role in present and past by analysis the Snow White character of *Snow White* movies.

This study is dealing about how women gender role happened in the past and the present era with qualitative research. The primary data in this study are derived from *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* and *Snow White and the Huntsman* films. Some sources are also taken from books, journals, articles, websites and thesis. The data are collected by watching the films, reading the scripts, identifying, classifying, and reducing.

The result of the study shows that women in the past era did not have many choices to do what they want. By following the era there are changes of the role of women, they have choices to do what they want as much as men do. CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION

This chapter shows introduction of the study that includes some points such as: background of the study, limitation of the study, problem formulation, objective of the study, significance of the study, and organization of the study.

A. Background of the Study

In society, there are social issues that always influence human life. "Social problem is usually taken to refer to social conditions that disrupt or damage society—crime, racism, and the like" (Best 2019). Thus, there are found some problem issues in society, such as; racism to black people, cyber bullying, discrimination gender and the like.

One of issue that develops in society is gender role, such as the different of gender in society. Amy Blackstone stated that "Gender roles are based on the different expectations that individuals, groups, and societies have of individuals based on their sex and based on each society's values and beliefs about gender" (335). According to the statement above, it can be learned that men have to work and women have to stay at home carrying the children. Thus, the role between men and women in society are different, it is following by values and belief in society.

In addition, Men in society have role as a competitive, independent, and preoccupied with their position within a hierarchy, then the women spirit is communal, egalitarian, and seeks cooperation and intimate connection (Qtd. in

Tieman 2015). It means that women have their activities in society that portray their gender and men also have their own.

Another statement is "gender roles determine how males and females should think, speak, dress and interact within the context of the society" (Ikegwu). Thus, it can be seen that gender roles are divided into masculine and feminine. Then, Borders and friends state in his article "societal standards of femininity and masculinity obviously exist; however, they may or may not be reflected in a woman's personal definition of her femininity or a man's personal definition of his masculinity" (67).

Thus, roles of women in society are more passive than men. It is also stated by Edwin Michael that female portrayed as people who have emotional feeling, submissive character, and also weak physical (74). As Michael's explanation above, women in society are weak and passive, so they depend on men in society life. Such as, men always help women for doing some work that need more power, for example cutting the firework or fix the car. Then, it can be seen that traditional women in the past that women should be doing homework and take care of children in the house.

By following the era, there are the role changes between women and men in society, especially women. As stated by Molly Edmonds, in 1960s and 1970s there are social changes caused of a cultural revolution. There are found many women go outside the home to pursue the careers. Then in the latest years, there are also found some men that doing domestic work (2018). Then, women in this era are people who no longer only control for domestic work.

In modern era, women also are independent people. They can go to school to study side by side with men. They are also doing politics and work in offices or companies (Wiley 2018). Thus, in this era many women found work in the companies or governments side by side with men. Such as; women work in the company as supervisor or manager. Then, they are also work as teacher and another job that can only men do in the past.

Furthermore, the sociology has connection with social society. The connection itself can happen on social activity or anything that happen in social life, including economic, religion, culture, and political. Swingewood and Laurenson (1972) stated that "sociology is essentially the scientific, objective of study man in society, the study of social institutions and of social process". Thus, from this statement can be seen that human in society are objective study of sociology. It is present with all aspects of life that lead to their interaction based on their status in society.

Accordingly, literary works usually have connected to social issues. Literary works are related to people's lives; even people are often able to determine the value in the literary work. Swingwood and Laurenson (1972) stated "Literature too is pre-eminently concerned with man's social world, his adaptation to it, and his desire to change it". Thus, literature is the work of art which present of human life and the problem on society, economics and politics with qualities of the relationship among them.

Another statement also said that the roles of men and women in society can be learned from literary works. Many of literary works, such as movies almost show about the role of men and women. "Literature must stand in recognizable relation to life in such a way that is in any case a selection from life" (Qtd. in Putri 2). Thus, the activities of men and women characters in the literary work especially movies can be seen that they have relation to the society, such as *Snow White* movies.

Moreover, there are some *Snow White* movies that have been produced. Then, the characters of each movie is different from each other, the characters are put by following the background of social life in the era producing movies. The first *Snow White* movie is from Disney Walt with entitled *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* that produced in 1937. Then, in this era *Snow White* movie is presented by Universal Studio with entitled *Snow White and the Huntsman* that produced in 2012. Thus, this study will discuss about the differences of women gender role in present and past by analysis the Snow White character of *Snow White* movies.

B. Limitation of the Study

This study analyzes about the differences of gender role that reflected in *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* (1937) and *Snow White and the Huntsman* (2012) movies. Then, this study will focus in women gender roles in the past and present that happen in the films as portrayed through the character of Snow White.

C. Problem Formulation

This study will express the analysis of the following problems:

- 1. How is the women gender role in the past that in *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* film portrayed?
- 2. How is the women gender role in the present *Snow White and the Huntsman* film portrayed?
- 3. How is the shift in gender role in the past and present that present in the *Snow White* films?

D. Objectives of the Study

This study will focus on the following objectives:

- 1. To analyze the women gender role that happens in the past through the Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs film.
- 2. To analyze the women gender role that happens in the present through the *Snow White and the Huntsman* film.
- 3. To analyze the shift in gender role in the past and present that present in the *Snow White* films.

E. Significance of the Study

This study is believed to be helpful for other as follows:

- This study hopefully can help student in discussing about the women gender role theory.
- 2. This study will provide references dealing with gender role theory for literature students in Sultan Agung Islamic University.

F. Organization of the study

Chapter one is the introduction which consist of the background of the study, limitation of the study, problem formulation, objectives of the study, significance of the study, and organization of the study. Chapter two is the reviews of related literature which consist of synopsis films and theory of women gender role. Chapter three is consist of the research method which contains types of the data, data collecting method and data analyzing method. Chapter four is consist of findings and discussions which contains of how the women gender roles portray in the *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* and *Snow White and the Huntsman* films. The last is chapter five that consist of the conclusion and suggestion of the study.

CHAPTER II REVIEWS OF RELATED LITERATURE

In this chapter, the theoretical framework is reviewed into two subchapters. First, there are synopsis of the film *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* and *Snow White and the Huntsman*. Review of related literature consists of definition of gender role. Then, gender role itself will discuss about women gender role in the past and the present era and also about the shift in gender role in the past and present.

A. Synopsis of Films

A.1 Synopsis of Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs (1937)

Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs is one animated film that produced by Walt Disney Production in 1937. This film tells about the princess who named Snow White. Snow White is a princess who has dream to meet a charming prince and married him to live happily. She lives with the evil Queen who always worries about Snow White because her beauty. Thus, she treats Snow White badly. Everyday Snow White has to work as scullery maid. The Queen also asks her magic mirror "who is fairest in the world" and the magic mirror always reply that the Queen is the fairest in world for years to pleasing her.

One day, the Queen asks the magic mirror but the magic mirror reply that Snow White is the fairest and it make the Queen mad. At the same time, Snow white meet the prince and falling in love to him. Then, the Queen commands the huntsman to bring Snow White to forest and kill her. She also commands the huntsman to bring Snow White's heart to proof that he has killed Snow White. However, the huntsman cannot kill Snow White and let her go.

Snow White runs in to the woods and get lost. In her fear, she meets forest creatures and makes friends. They take her to a cottage in the deep of the woods. In the cottage, she finds seven small chairs and untidy rooms. Thus, she assume who live in the cottage are the orphaned children. Then, she decides to clean the cottage. After cleaning the cottage, she is tired and fall asleep. When she wakes up, she sees seven dwarfs who are the owners of the cottage. Then, she asks to be allowed to lives with them. Afterwards, she lives with the dwarfs together. When she lives with them, she always does the housewife work, such as clean the room and cook for the dwarfs.

Meanwhile, the Queen realizes that Snow White still alive. Thus, she make poison apple to give for Snow White. Then, she disguises as old woman and goes to the cottage where Snow White lives. She knocks the door and offers the apples to Snow White. Then, Snow White who is alone in cottage opens the door and meets her. The Queen offers the apple with fools Snow White, she said that it is the magic apple which can grants the wishes. Snow White believes it and eats the apple. Then, Snow White falls asleep and the Queen claims that she is the fairest in the land. However, when the Queen escapes from the dwarfs, she is strikes by the lighting and dies.

Then, the dwarfs laid Snow White in a glass coffin. A year later, a Prince who came to Snow White's chest and realized that Snow White was the Princess he is looking for. The Prince sad to see Snow White then kissed her and Snow

White's curse is broken. Afterwards, the Prince takes the Snow White to the kingdom and life happily.

A.2 Synopsis of Snow White and the Huntsman (2012)

Snow White and the Huntsman is remake film from Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs that produced in 2012. This film tells about the Princess named Snow White. Her life is changed after her father dead and Ravenna claim herself as the queen of the kingdom. Snow White tried to escape but she fails. Snow White is locked up in a tower near the sea. In the tower, she meets many beautiful women who is locked up and exploited by Ravenna.

One day, the queen, Ravenna, ask the mirror "who is the fairest in the world". Then, the mirror tells that Snow White is the prettiest and who can eat her heart, she will get beauty and stay young. Then, the Queen commands her brother, Finn, to bring Snow White. However, Snow White attacks him and gets away to the dark forest. Ravenna is mad. Then, she commands the huntsman, Eric, to catch Snow White.

However, Snow White convinces Eric to help her. Then, they have arrived at a village where women hide from Ravenna. They stay in the village for a while. However, Finn and his troops come to catch them. Finn commands his troops to burns the village. Fortunately, Snow White and Eric can get away even there are people died.

On the way, they are saved by the dwarfs from Finn. Then, the dwarfs bring them to the fairy forest. When they take a rest in the forest, Snow White sees the deer and follows it. Nevertheless, when she follows the deer, she meets Finn. Then, there is a scramble between the huntsman and Finn. Finn is killed and they are got away.

The death of Finn makes Ravenna angry. Then, she disguises as William, Snow White's first love, and gives her an apple. Snow White who does not know that he is Ravenna takes the apple. She bites the apple and fall down. Then, Ravenna changes to her truth appearance and tries to kill Snow White. However, she is failed because Eric and William come.

Unfortunately, Snow White is died because of poison. William who is desperate kisses Snow White. However, she still does not open her eyes. Then, they take Snow White to the castle to hold a funeral ceremony.

Eric, the huntsman, who is amazed and fell in love with Snow White, quietly approached Snow White's body. He sadly said goodbye and kissed her. Miraculously, Snow White opens her eyes and wake up. Then, Snow White come to the residents and led a rebellion against Ravenna.

B. Related Literature

B.1 Gender Role

Gender is one belief in society that describes of individuals on their socials grounds. Gender role means how people expect to act, speak, dress, and conduct themselves based on their gender. Then, Gender roles basically have different expectations in society for individuals, groups, and society which are usually determined by their gender and society's values and beliefs about gender.

"Understanding the term "gender roles" requires an understanding of the term "gender't"Gender" is a social term that is often confused with the term "sex:' Sex and gender are different concepts. Sex is a biological concept, determined on the basis of individuals' primary sex characteristics. Gender, on the other hand, refers to the meanings, values, and characteristics that people ascribe to different sexes" (Blackstone 336).

Furthermore, there are differences role between women and men in society. Women usually do activity in the house, such as carrying children and housekeeping. Then, men usually work outside of the house because they have strong physical and seemed capable. Thus men have responsibility to keep women and children. "One way that a woman might engage in the traditional feminine gender role would be to nurture her family by working full-time within the horne rather than taking employment outside of the home. Men, on the other hand, are presumed by traditional views of gender roles to be leaders" (Blackstone 337).

Moreover, "gender roles are often discussed in terms of an individual's gender role orientation, which is typically described as either traditional or nontraditional. A traditional gender role orientation emphasizes differences between men and women and assumes that each sex has a natural affinity to particular behaviors" (Blackstone 338). People who maintain traditional gender role orientation affected by the rules and rituals of the generation before them, by parents and grandparents. Then, individual with nontraditional gender role more believe that in the value of egalitarian relationship between men and women is determined on the strength and ability of individual human beings to determine

what role they want to occupy and the extent to which that role should be related to their gender.

B.2 Women Gender Role in the Past Era

In the history, women are one of victims of patriarchy and confined the sphere. The lives of western women in the past are not many different from eastern women. As June stated that "Western women, like their eastern sisters, organized their lives around domesticity and piety, and then used those concepts to expand their spheres" (93). Thus, in the past women just do housewife work. For example housekeeping and carrying the children.

Another statement also said that "Traditionally, many Western societies have believed that women are more nurturing than men. Therefore, the traditional view of the feminine gender role prescribes that women should behave in ways that are nurturing" (Blactstone 337). Thus, there is believed that women have to stay at home being good wife and mother for children. Then, June also said that in the western literature the women usually have images of portray women's domesticity and submissiveness as fixed and inevitable (96).

In the nineteenth century, women usually are known as inferior and men as the superior sex. It is because those men are believed to be stronger, both physically and mentally, than women. Then, women usually could not express their opinions and moved freely in society. Sindradóttir stated "in the nineteenth century, women were not considered to be equal to men. Therefore they did not have the same rights or the same opportunities that were presented to men in this period" (Sindradóttir 2). There is believed that men and women occupy separate

spaces that are considered very different from each other. Thus, women usually have passive role than men in society; they cannot explore themselves like men.

In the nineteenth century era, women were not going to school and women who can manage the household and become a housewife were good women. Fatima stated that women in Victorian era were less skilled at work because most women in the 19th century did not receive a formal education like men because it was not uncommon for women to attend school. Women are required to be a good wife to their husband and a good mother to their children. So what women pay the most attention to is being a good woman who can keep the household in a good direction (Qtd. in Millati 14).

Another statement said "Late 19th to early 20th century media representations of femininity were primarily defined by traditional discourses of femininity that construct women as caring, domestic and nurturing" (Qtd. Dam 7). Thus, most of women in the past era usually stayed at home carrying the children and did house duties, while men worked outside to earn money.

Furthermore, in society believe that women are not strong as men, for example in society women are famous as gentle and emotional rather than men that considered are strong and rational. Thus, there are many women believed that women should stay at home being wife and mother in the past. Then, Rendall said that "domestic focus of women's lives, to be narrowly limited to home and family, was justified and give n ideological unity in the nineteenth century by a range of arguments, resting on women's nature, on God's ordinances, on the evidence of past and present societies" (Qtd. in Sindradóttir 1).

Moreover, Showalter stated that "the more passive, private sphere of the household and home where their inborn emotional talents would serve them best (Qtd. in Sindradóttir 1). Thus, usually women had to teach their children what is right and wrong morally as society standards. For example, in society women have to be able to do housekeeping and carrying children and they do not allow go outside, such as go to the school to study. Then, Hays explained that in the beginning World War II, the norms are changing. It is because many women go to work outside house to replace their husbands who went to war. However, these are just temporary job and they are seen incapable doing man's work. Thus, they have to back to their roles, domestic work and carrying children.

B.3 Women Role in the Present Era

By following the era, in the end of 20th century and beginning 21st century the role of women have changed. Today, women have a many choices and better lifestyle rather than women in the past. Commonly, women stay at home do housekeeping duties and carrying children. However, today women do not stay at home anymore; they also can do activity outside as much as men do. There are found many women go outside the home to pursue the careers. Then, according to Nurhadi, there are also found some men that doing domestic work in late years (2018). Then, women in this era are people who no longer only control for domestic work.

Furthermore, in the 21st century as the era of Third Wave Feminism, all women believe that it is the era when women and girls are doing fine. There are some movements such as Girl Power who strengthens the women's power without

leave their identity as a woman (Oktaviani and Arimbi 56). In this era, women are strong and independent rather than in the past. The societies accept their strength because the women can do things for themselves as well as others. Thus, it can be seen that women in the modern era have strengthens to solve their problem.

In addition, women in the past century did not have chances to choose what they want to do. In the past women usually automatically being house wife and staying at home to raise children. However, in the 21st century women have opportunity to choose what they like and what they want to do. According to Agrawal and Joglekar, women in 21st century are recognized their rights and obligations as well as their work situation. Thus, women usually only limited in house duties, today they can join work with men. There are many occupations that women can do, such as doctor, politician, architect and many more. Then, besides being a good wife and mother, women can also be good entrepreneurs and decision makers (2013).

B.4 The Shift in Gender Role in the Past and Present

Gender role is one of problem that can be focus in social life. Amy Blackstone stated that "Gender roles are based on the different expectations that individuals, groups, and societies have of individuals based on their sex and based on each society's values and beliefs about gender". Thus, the roles of men and women in society are usually different. It is following by values and belief in society.

In most countries, the roles of women in society are usually more passive than roles of men. However, nowadays gender roles are shifting from past to present since women become more aware that there should be equality in gender. "The practices of gender inequality in most parts of the world, especially in the United States of America automatically trigger the reconstruction of gender roles proposed by the feminists. Gender roles are not static and change as the needs of society change" (Qtd. in Afandi 8).

Because of development of society, there are changes in gender role. In the past, traditional gender role make men to be masculine and women to be feminine. "They assume that men should have masculine traits and behaviors according to what are listed in what the masculinists call 'Act like a Man' Box, whereas women are expected to follow the feminine attributes. 'Boys do not cry' is one of the common traditional masculinities, whereas 'girls do not yell' is an example of traditional femininity" (Afandi 9).

In the present, women do not always stay at home and carrying children. According to Bandler, women in the present have more chance and opportunity to finding appropriate job, and also the can improve their skills in accurate way based on their needs. Nevertheless, the modern societies think that the attendance and activities of women equal men at work.

Furthermore, according to Haines women have more representation and more visibility in the workplace, on sports fields, and in educational institutions today than they had many years ago (2016). Thus, it can be seen that women have more change to develop their ability and grow in the society.

Actually, the revival and wave of feminism movement happen in the late 1960s and early 1970s, but that issues do not have effect in society. However the

mentality went from in the 1970s with two-thirds of Americans believing that women belonged in the home caring for the family, to the 1990s with two-thirds of American rejecting that notion (Qtd. Barber 19). Thus, there many women are seen in the workplaces, schools or colleges.

Therefore this study will be discuss about women gender role in the past and in the present that happened in the *Snow White* films, there are *Snow White* and the *Seven Dwarfs* and *Snow White* and the *Huntsman* films. This study also uses sociology approach to analyze the films.



CHAPTER III RESEARCH METHOD

In this chapter tells about research method. There are types of the research, data organizing and data analyzing.

A. Type of the Research

This study used qualitative method since the data was reported descriptively and delivered in sentences. Snyder stated that a qualitative approach has been established to measure the quality and strength of findings or conclusion from any kinds of studies and to compare the results. Usually, this is described as a method of comparing findings from qualitative studies and referred as a qualitative systematic review. In other word, a qualitative approach is used to assess the articles and a careful systematic review process is used to collect the articles (Snyder 335). Based on the explanations above, the writer used qualitative research as method of research.

B. Data Organizing

B.1 Data Collecting Method

There were steps that used in collecting the data. The steps were:

B.1.1 Watching the Films

The object of the research was a movie. The documentation was done by watching *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* and *Snow White and The Huntsman* films repeatedly. Then, the writer was finds the main problem in this movie which relates to the social condition and finds the women gender role occur in the movie.

B.1.2 Reading the Scripts

Besides watching the films, the writer also did reading the scripts. The writer analyzes the research by reading the scripts of the *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* and *Snow White and the Huntsman* films that relates to the social conditions and finds the women gender roles that occur in the films.

B.1.3 Identifying the Data

Data identification was to underline and classify so-called data on the object of study and secondary sources to separate data and non-data. This method could help identify data based on what the author wants to analyze. All kinds of data could come in a form of dialogue, narrative, or the many other possibilities that can be found in primary and secondary sources.

B.1.4 Classifying the Data

Data classifying meant grouping data based on the formulation of the problem to be discussed in the research. This study had two problem formulations to be discussed. When the results from primary and secondary data of the two problem formulation have been written, it can be seen in the appendix table.

B.1.5 Reducing the Data

Data reduction was the final step in the data collection process. This data reduction was performed by a small amount of data from a larger database.

B.2 Types of the Data

This study was using two kinds of data; there are primary data and secondary data.

1. Primary data was the main data which had been collected from the film as the primary source. The primary data itself taken from *Snow White and the*

Seven Dwarfs by Walt Disney and Snow White and the Huntsman by Universal Pictures. Since the objects of the study are films, the kind of data is in form of monolog, dialogue and picture in the films.

 Secondary data was data which is taken from books, journals, article, magazine, or website that related with the study as supporting the primary data.

C. Data Analyzing

In analyzing the data, the writer uses descriptive analysis the data. The final project analysis was taken from selected data, such as dialogue, monolog and pictures, with its reason why the data support to answer the problems. The complete analysis was written in chapter IV as the result of this study while the whole supporting data are shown in the appendix.

CHAPTER IV FINDING AND DISCUSSING

In this chapter, the writer will discuss about the finding and analysis how the women gender role portrayed in *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* film and *Snow White and the Huntsman* films.

A. The Women Gender Role in Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs

In the past society, women gender role is one of social issue that had be focus in social life. There are many rules and values that have to obey in society. Snow White and the seven dwarfs that released in 1937 by Walt Disney is one of movie that portrayed about women gender role in the past. It means that women in the past era did not have many choices to do what they want. They have rule that their activity just around domesticity and piety.

Another statement also said that "Traditionally, many Western societies have believed that women are more nurturing than men. Therefore, the

traditional view of the feminine gender role prescribes that women should behave in ways that are nurturing" (Blactstone 337). Thus, there is believed that women have to stay at home being good wife and mother for children. Then, June also said that in the western literature the women usually have images of portray women's domesticity and submissiveness as fixed and inevitable (96).

Thus, women usually have passive role than men in society; they cannot explore themselves like men.



Doc: 't ain't new year.


Snow white: oh, perhaps you have washed. (00.39.50)





The writer also suggests that *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* and *Snow White* and the Huntsman films to be analyzed in the different approach. In this analysis, the writer only focuses how women gender role are portrayed by the main character of the

films. Thus, *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* and *Snow White and the Huntsman* films also can be analyzed using another approach such as symbolism.
