Background: The incidence of adolescent aggression cannot be blamed only the personal teenagers only, but the family, the environment, communities and even nations. Preliminary studies conducted in high school Futuhiyyah Mranggen showed that in May 2014 there was a brawl involving high school student Futuhiyyah Mranggen because the problem is not clear. Efforts to prevent student misbehavior has been done by increasing the activity as a hobby outside of school students as extra music, basketball, nature lovers, soccer and futsal, but the incidence of fights between students still common. The purpose of this study is to find out information about the influence of the school environment and family environment on drinking behavior in vocational "X" Demak.

Methods: This study is a quantitative research correlation. Research Study of the correlation is essentially a research or study the relationship between two or more variables in a situation or a group of subjects. The approach used is cross sectional ie the data obtained today. The sample in this study was 52 students. The analysis used logistic regression.

Results: The majority of respondents were in a good family environment with a number of 30 respondents (57.7%). Most respondents were in a good school environment with a number of 35 respondents (67.3%). Most respondents behave not drinking the number of 38 respondents (73.1%).

Conclusion: There is a family environment influences the behavior of drinking with a p-value of 0.024. There is a school environment influences the behavior of drinking with a p-value of 0.000. The variables that most influence on the behavior of teenage drinking is a neighborhood school with $\text{Exp (B)} = 52.391$
