Latar Belakang : Menjaga kesehatan gigi dan mulut yaitu dengan cara menggosok gigi yang harus diajarkan orang tua kepada anak sejak usia dini, keberhasilan itu dipengaruhi oleh beberapa faktor salah satunya pengajaran cara menggosok gigi dengan benar dan teratur pada anak *preschool*. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah mengetahui perubahan perilaku menggosok gigi yang benar pada anak *preschool* melalui media *flip chart* pada kelompok intervensi dan kontrol sebelum dan sesudah dilakukan perlakuan.

Metode : Penelitian ini merupakan jenis penelitian kuantitatif menggunakan metode *Quasy eksperimental*. Pengumpulan data menggunakan kuesioner dan menggunakan instrumen *flip chart*. Jumlah responden sebanyak 120 anak *Preschool* dengan tehnik *non random purposive sampling* dengan menggunakan uji *T dependen, T independen, Wilcoxon, dan Mann-Withney*.

Hasil : Berdasarkan hasil analisis dari 120 responden, menunjukkan hasil uji *Simple Paired T-test* pada kelompok intervensi diperoleh nilai *p value* 0,000 (*p-value* <0,050), uji pada minggu kedua dan ketiga menggunakan *wilcoxon*, didapatkan hasil tidak ada beda antara posttest pada minggu pertama, kedua, dan ketiga. Hasil uji statistik *Mann Whitney* diperoleh nilai *p-value* 0.000 (*p-value*<0,05), dan disimpulkan ada perbedaan yang bermakna antara perubahan perilaku menggosok gigi yang benar pada kelompok intervensi dan kontrol.

Simpulan : Ada perbedaan antara perubahan perilaku menggosok gigi yang benar pada *preschool* melalui media *flip chart* pada kelompok intervensi dengan kelompok kontrol di Tk Pertiwi 9 Siwiasih dan Tk Darul Hasanah Genuk kota Semarang.

Background: Maintaining oral health is by brushing teeth that should be taught by parents to their own children from an early age, the success is influenced by several factors, one of them is teaching how to brush their teeth correctly and regularly in preschool children. The purpose of this study was to find out the behavior change of brushing teeth correctly in preschool children through flip chart media in intervention and control groups before and after being given treatments.

Methods: This study was a quantitative study by using quasi experimental design. The data was collected by applying questionnaire and flip chart instruments. The total respondents were 120 Preschool children with non-random purposive sampling technique by utilizing T dependent-test, T independent-test, Wilcoxon and Mann-Whitney statistic test.

Results: Based on the analysis of 120 respondents, it showed the results of Simple Paired T-test in intervention group were obtained p value 0.000 (p-value <0.050), the test on the second and third week by using Wilcoxon statistic test, it showed there was no difference between post-test in the first, second, and third week. Mann Whitney statistic test result was obtained p-value 0.000 (p-value <0.05), and it was concluded there was a significant difference between the behavior change of brushing teeth correctly in intervention and control group.

Conclusion: There was a difference between the behavior change of brushing teeth correctly at preschool through flip chart media in the intervention group and control group at the Pertiwi Kindergarten 9 Siwiasih and Darul Hasanah Kindergarten of Genuk Semarang.
